Frequently Asked Questions

How far is Rancho Seco from Elk Grove?

Approximately 40 minutes.

Is the Rancho Seco parking fee included in the camping registration fee?

No, Rancho Seco charges a parking fee of \$12/day that is NOT included in the camping registration fee and must be paid at time of entry. We recommend car pooling!

Is there electricity at the group campsite?

No, but there will be a small generator for casual use.

Are there bathrooms and showers available?

Yes.

Can I attend Friday night only?

Yes.

What if I have special dietary needs?

Unfortunately we cannot provide special meals, however you are welcome to bring your own food and drinks.

How late can I stay at the camp on Sunday?

Departure from the group campsite is 12:00 pm however you can stay in the park until closing.

Can I arrive late or leave early?

Yes, we realize you may have other commitments.

If I register and can't attend can I get my money back?

Refunds will be issued up to two weeks prior to the campout.

Is it strictly tent camping or can I bring a motorhome?

The Father Son Campout reserves a group campsite that allows for tent camping only.

Do I need to be a member of Creekside to attend the campout? No

Do I need a fishing license?

Depends on your age. If you are 16 years or older, you must have a California fishing license which are available to purchase at Rancho Seco.

Is fishing equipment provided?

No. Fishing poles, gear or supplies are not provided.
