PUT IT INTO ACTION!

upside down water

Gather an index card, 1/3 cup of water, and a cup. Pour the water inside the cup. Place the index card over the mouth of the cup, making sure it's completely covered. Place one hand on top of the index card and use the other hand to quickly flip the cup over. Hold the index card for a few seconds, then remove your hand.

The index card should keep the water from flowing out of the now upside-down cup. Explain how in this experiment, the index card represents God's Word, the water temptation, and the cup us. When temptation comes (water flipped upside down inside the cup), God's Word (index card) can help us not give into it.

Tip: Do this trick over the sink, especially when attempting it for the first time.
