LifeGroup Discussion Questions / Week of May 31 – June 6, 2026

## Prayer

Begin in prayer that the Lord calms our minds of the distractions of this world. Pray that our hearts be open to grow deeper in our faith, and to see the opportunities to serve more faithfully in the places and with the people the Lord has given us.

## My Story

What are you best at? What are your strengths, talents, and things that you believe you do well?

## Digging Deep

1. Thinking back on Sunday's message, what idea or lesson stood out to you the most?
2. Do you consider yourself to be "disruptable"? In other words, do you allow yourself to be disrupted with the regular rhythms of life in order to be intentional with opportunities to serve those in need around you?
3. **Read John 20:19-21.** Imagine Jesus appearing after His resurrection. What kind of reaction would you expect from the disciples after this incredible experience with the risen Lord? If you had been there, what might have been your reaction?
4. Jesus says He is sending us as (or in a similar way) the Father has sent Him. What does Jesus mean by this? What does this mean for our own lives?

5. If a non-Christian were to ask you, "Why was Jesus here on earth?" how would you answer that question? How can we as Christ followers participate in this mission?
6. **Read Ephesians 4:1-6.**
  - How does Paul describe a life "worthy of the calling" believers have received?
  - What is the responsibility of the collective church?
  - How do individual Christians fit within this mission of the church?
  - Share of a time when you experienced genuine unity within the church, your family, or community.

## Taking It Home

7. If someone were to ask you, "What is your mission in life?" how would you answer that? Take some time to reflect on your answer, and then share it with another person.
8. Jesus sends out His disciples as the Father has sent Him to this world. What is Jesus sending you to do? How are you feeling called to serve Him in this season?

Pray that we would see Jesus' deep sacrificial love for us, and respond with an overwhelming joy so that we may join in His mission of redemption.
